Theme & Passages	Trinity Sunday: Image bearers Gen 1:24-27, 2 Cor 13:11-13, Matt 28:6-20, Ps 8 Notes prepared by Gill Hawkins
Welcome (10 mins) Worship (15 mins)	Gill talked about selfies on Sunday; tell the group about either your most embarrassing selfie/photograph or the one you're most proud of. - Begin by thinking about what aspect of His character each of you have felt God show you more of recently and share briefly how He did that. - Listen to 'The Splendour of the King' https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=KBD18rsVJHk or another worship song that speaks of the Trinity - Pray out your worship of the greatness of our God and His love for humanity
Working with God (20 mins)	Saturday 17 th June is Bookham Village Day, an opportunity to get out and about , celebrate the village of Bookham and meet neighbours and others in the community.
5 marks of mission:	Pray for those who faithfully volunteer to put on these events for the benefit of our community.

Word (20 mins)	 Read Gen 1:24-27 Image bearers As you think of mankind resembling/bearing the image of God, how do you react? Read Ps 8 together, what stands out to you in the Psalm about God's attitude to mankind? How might's God's view of you differ from your own self-view? Can anyone share a testimony of when understanding more of who God is has led to a change in your self-understanding? Is there an area of your life in which you believe God's image has become distorted? Can you ask your SG to pray about it with you?
