## IN SMALL GROUPS

- What inspires you? Bring it into the worship time.
- Pulling objects out of a bag. How do they reflect something of God?
- Use pictures and art
- Light a candle
- Use poetry
- Invite 'popcorn' prayers (short, quick fire prayers)
- Create a 'thankfulness jar'
- Keep a prayer diary: record prayers and answers
- Develop your own kit box with resources and materials
- Spend time in silence
- Engage the senses (listening, smell, taste, touch)
- Share a traditional Passover meal
- Reflect on pop songs
- Plasticine / clay modelling

- Ignatian method of reading scripture

- Remove shoes to acknowledge holy ground
- Use stones in buckets for confessions and prayers
- Text message a response

- Use incense
- Lead a reflection or meditation
- Print your fingerprints
- Use glow sticks to represent light in the dark
- Create a prayer wall
- Prophetic headlines (cutting and pasting news stories)
