

Theme & Passage	All things Reconciled: Breaking down walls Ephesians 2:14-22
Welcome	Tell the group of a time when you felt like a square peg in a round hole; how did you feel, what happened, what helped?
Worship	<p>Try some silence! Light candle, calm your thoughts, focus on being present to Christ as He is present.</p> <p>Read each passage slowly with breaks between: Psalm 118 : 22-23 Acts 4:8-12 Romans 9:33 1 Peter 2:4-6</p> <p>After some meditative silence pray out your worship to Jesus for what He has done and who He is in your lives.</p>
Word/ Read & Reflect	<p>Read through Ephesians 2:14-22 a couple of times and then share together from your present thoughts or memories from Sunday's preaching.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. What is your understanding of the significance of Jesus breaking down of the 'wall of hostility'? Is there a wider meaning than uniting Jew and Gentile in Himself? 2. What is your experience of Jesus breaking down walls of hostility? 3. Share what it means to your life to have access to the Father (v18)? Do you sometimes take it for granted? <p>Pray for those who feel a challenge to move on in this area.</p>
Working it out	<p>Your small group is an expression of God's work to build you together into His dwelling (v22). Give the group a few minutes to each write down three ways in which your group reflects this truth and one way in which you think you as an individual might encourage the process.</p> <p>Bless one another to close</p>
